In granting this sanction or approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming (USAS) and Inland Empire Swimming (IES) shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. Use of audio or visual recording, including the use of a cell phone camera, is not allowed in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Deck changing is PROHIBITED: changing into or out of swimsuits other than in the facility locker rooms, or other designated area designated by the host facility, is not appropriate and is prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

HOST: Baker YMCA Swim Team Barracudas (BST)

LOCATION: Sam O Pool, 580 Baker Street, Baker City, OR 97814

FACILITIES: 25 yard indoor, 6-lane pool. Starting blocks in the deep end only. Pool depth is 3.5' to 6.5'. In water starts required for the 25 yard events and at the 2nd and 4th legs of the 100 yard relays. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

Swim venue includes: Men's and Women's locker rooms with access onto the pool deck.

Seating available for 100 spectators. Spectators are requested to stay in the seating area.

Lifeguards will be on duty at all times during warm-ups and during the meet.

TIME: *All times are Pacific Daylight Time*
Saturday/Sunday: Warm-ups 9:00 – 9:45 am
Events begin at 10:00 am
Official's meeting at 9:15 am
Coaches meeting at conclusion of warm-ups.

RULES: Current USAS Official Rules will govern the meet. The rules and procedures of IES also apply. The Referee of the meet shall be the final authority for the conduct of the competition. Swimmers participating in the meet without a coach must report to the Meet Referee prior to the warm-ups for instructions. Coaches must be currently registered with USA Swimming. Proof of certification must be produced at any time upon request from the Meet Referee. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being

proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Only swimmers, coaches, officials and meet workers are permitted in the deck area. Spectators will not be allowed in deck area without proof of current USA Swimming membership. The deck area is considered to be a 3 foot area from the edge of the pool and the area behind the start platforms up to the timer chairs.

TIMING: The Daktronics Timing System and electronic scoreboard with touchpads will be the primary time recording system; however, lane timers will be needed throughout the meet. Each team will be asked to share in the timing duties.

500 freestyle swimmers must provide their own counters and timers.

ELIGIBILITY: Entrants will not be limited to USA Swimming members, and may include YMCA swimmers at this meet. Age on the first day of the meet determines the age group to enter. **Athletes with a disability are welcome and are asked to provide advance notice of necessary accommodations.**

SWIMS: **The USA Swimming SWIMS database requires that ALL swimmer data be correct before any meet data (swimmer times) will be loaded into the USA Swimming database. If you know of any swimmer data that is NOT correct in the meet database please notify the meet referee as soon as possible. The appropriate changes will be made. The data will be sent to USA Swimming within 3 days of the meet. Thank you for your cooperation.**

ENTRIES: All events are timed finals. All swimmers may enter a maximum of **FIVE** individual events and one relay per day. Please submit **YARD TIMES** for seeding. NT times will be accepted. Entries will be limited to those swims that allow the meet to stay within the prescribed time limit. The date of receipt of entries determines precedence of entry. No on-deck registrations will be permitted. The order of events may be revised and/or events may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Positive Check In **MAY BE REQUIRED** for events 200 yards or longer; at the discretion of the Meet Referee, the number of heats of events 200 yards or longer may be limited.

Entries must be submitted by the following method:

- 1) Email Hy-tek entries for individual and relays no later than Wednesday, April 25, 2018. No late entries will be accepted.
- 2) Full payment and hard copies of Hy-tek information (previously submitted via email) must be received by Monday, Apr 30, 2018.

Please include the name, phone number, and email of a contact person for entry questions or notification of entry limitations for purposes of maintaining the timeline within duration limitations.

ENTRY FEES: \$12.00 IES surcharge per swimmer
\$3.00 individual event fee
\$12.00 relay entry fee
Entry fees must accompany master entry form.

Checks must be payable in U.S. funds to Baker Swim Team.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received no later than WEDNESDAY, APRIL 25, 2018. Entries are limited to include teams up to and including the team that has the 120th swimmer entered. If you have questions concerning the meet or your entries, contact Julie Huntington, 406-202-0625.

TIMELINE MANAGEMENT:

In order to keep the time-line in compliance with USA Swimming rules, relays and individual events may be combined.

SCORING: Scoring will be done by individual age groups (8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over) and those points count towards individual high point. All individual events will be scored, relays will not be scored. Scoring will be to the 12th place.

USMS swimmers will be seeded in the 15 & Over events; they will not score in the events.

High Point: Each AGE, Boy/Girl based on individual events, not relays.

OFFICIALS: Visiting officials are welcome and encouraged to help. Please bring current certification and USA Swimming registration cards; these will be verified by the meet referee before deck assignments are made. ***The uniform is a White Polo Shirt, blue shorts/pants/skirt, and white shoes.***

WARMUP PROCEDURES;

Meet marshals will be on deck during warm-ups. Deck marshals have the authority to remove, with concurrence of the referee, any swimmer, coach, or club from the warm-up or the meet who do not follow the safety rules.

Certified coaches must be on the deck during warm-ups. Swimmers who participate without their USA Swimming certified coach present must notify the Meet Referee prior to warm-up. The swimmer will be assigned to a coach.

SAFETY:

No diving from the blocks or sides of pool except for designated sprint lanes during designated times in pool. Coaches are responsible for their team's swimmers throughout the meet, including warm-up and warm down.

MISC:

Each swimmer is responsible to report to the proper heat and lane for their events.

No smoking, tobacco, glass containers, or alcoholic beverages are allowed within the pool area or the park.

Programs & limited concessions will be available during meet hours. A Hospitality room will be provided for coaches and officials.

Only authorized volunteers and working personnel are permitted on deck. All others must remain in the spectator areas provided and outside of the designated deck area. The area behind the starting blocks is not open to parents/spectators.

Overflow parking is available in designated area across from facility.

From I-84 West, take exit 304. Turn Right onto Campbell Street. Take 1st left onto Birch Street, then 1st left onto Baker Street. Sam O Pool is on left at 580 Baker St.
